## Studio grant at the ISCP in New York 2012 - 2013

The studio grant in New York is for participation in the International Studio and Curatorial Program (ISCP), which is a residency-based art institution founded in 1994. ISCP is located in East Williamsburg, Brooklyn and pursues a comprehensive programme including visiting critics, field trips, open studios, and a series of artist talks and exhibitions. Iaspis provides a centrally located two-room apartment on Hudson Street for the grant holder. With 35+ artists and curators in residence at all times, and with 120+ residents over the course of a year, ISCP is a vibrant community of contemporary art practitioners. ISCP is committed to the production and dissemination of innovative and challenging contemporary art and to positioning artists and curators at the forefront of cultural and social change.

The Swedish grant has existed since 1994 and is intended for professional visual artists and designers.

The next grant period is **15 September 2012 – 31 August 2013**. A grant of SEK 250,000 from Iaspis is intended as a contribution to travel expenses and subsistence.

**The application should reach the Swedish Arts Grants Committee no later than 18 January 2012.** The Visual Arts Fund's delegation for Iaspis will select the grant holder and announce its decision at the end of February.
