Studio grant in Tokyo (AIT) 2012

Since 2003 Iaspis has a three-month studio residency at AIT in Tokyo.

The AIT is an organisation in Tokyo that operates in a similar way to Iaspis within the sphere of contemporary art. The AIT is a platform for initiatives on an art scene that is currently undergoing major changes and experiencing an increased interest from the public. The AIT's activities include education, seminars, lectures, exhibitions and guest studios. Many activities are carried out in collaboration with other organisations.

The grant at the AIT includes access to the AIT's programme, accommodation and a grant of SEK 160,000 to cover travel expenses, subsistence and work-related costs. Please note that the grant does not include a studio/work space. If such a space is required, the AIT may be able to help in organising this, but this is not a component of the grant that Iaspis currently offers.
