

STUDIO RESIDENCY AT IASPIS

About the grant

The studios are located on the Swedish Arts Grants Committee's premises at Maria skolgata 83 in Stockholm. Grant recipients must arrange their own accommodation. A grant of 25,000 SEK/month will be awarded to cover costs for subsistence, accommodation and expenses for work.

For artists in the residency program, it is important to be present as much as possible for exchange with the fellow residency artists. The programme offers a varied program of studio conversations with invited Swedish and international curators and critics, joint study visits to other institutions, artist talks and more.

The residency is research-based without requirement for results. There is no additional funding for production. The residence periods are three or six months. There are four studios for artists based in Sweden. In the application you can specify the length and period that suits you best.

The deadline for applications is 5 December 2022, 14.00.

Application instructions

The grants are available for profession practitioners in visual arts, design, craft and architecture who are based in or residents of Sweden.

If you have an *e-legitimation* (Swedish electronic identification), you can apply at www.konstnarsnamnden.se until 14.00 the 5 December. If you submit a paper application it must reach the Swedish Arts Grants Committee no later than 14:00 on 5 December.

Work samples

With your application you should include 5-10 work samples which are preferably from the last 2 years. If you apply via the Swedish Arts Grants Committee's e-service you can submit image, sound and film files. However, with a paper application it is only possible to submit images on A4-sheets. Paper applications are scanned by the Swedish Arts Grants Committee and made available to the members of the Iaspis delegation in digital format. Thus it is important that all appendices are in a standing format as they will be read on a screen. You may also send the pdf-application to us by e-mail, with work samples attached to the same e-mail.

Prioritisation and criteria

During the assessment process, the Iaspis delegation will primarily focus on the scope and quality of your artistic practice. Motivation as well as description of your artistic practice is of great importance. The delegation strives to achieve equal distribution and diversity in regard to genres, gender, age, geographic distribution,

IASPIS is the Swedish Arts Grants Committee's international programme for professional practitioners in visual arts, design, crafts and architecture. The Iaspis programme is tasked with promoting contacts between artists in Sweden and actors on the international arena and thus contribute to artistic development and improved working conditions. Through the Iaspis programme, it is possible to apply for grants for international cultural exchange including exhibitions, study and work residencies abroad, and international collaborative projects in Sweden. The exchange programme comprises nine studios for Swedish and international artists in Stockholm, studios for invited international artists in Gothenburg, Malmö and Umeå, as well as eight studios abroad for artists based in Sweden.

The material will be scanned and made available in digital format for the examiners. Thus, it is important that the work samples fit into a standing A4 sheet. Do not use tape or staples.
